

## ***INTERCESSION RELEASES JUSTICE AND JUDGEMENT THROUGH THE END TIME CHURCH***

### **Introduction**

The end time Church has a prophetic calling upon her. Much like the Apostle John who was given the prophetic call to reveal to the church their calling and purpose during the last years prior to the second coming of our Lord, the generation in which the Lord returns will be equipped with prophetic insight into the end time events. The church of that day will be used to trumpet the end time events that the Holy Spirit begins to reveal unto her.

- 1) Revelation chapter 1 reveals to the church her end-time prophetic calling in the generation that the Lord returns. Rev 1:1, 1:3, 1:19
- 2) Revelation chapters 2-3 equips the end-time church with prophetic messages that will prepare God's people to live holy lives and prepare us for the hour of tribulation. By adhering to the seven letters, the prophetic truths found in them will make us overcomers in that day and hour. Rev 2-3
- 3) Revelation chapters 4-5 reveal to us the splendor, majesty, glory and worthiness of Jesus Christ. His sacrifice on the cross as the Lamb of God has qualified Him to be the Lion of the Tribe of Judah and to receive the scroll from the Father's hand. The scroll in Revelation 5:1 is the title deed of the earth. It contains God's action plan to purge the earth from all sin and satanic influence. Rev 5:4-5
- 4) Chapters 6-22 reveal 21 judgments that God will unleash through the Son of God in partnership with the praying church, the Bride of Christ. These 21 judgements will purge the earth from all evil and satanic rule through the anti-christ and the false prophet. Rev 6:1, 8:6, 16:1

### **I. ON EARTH AS IT IS IN HEAVEN**

Both Moses and David had prophetic revelations to the spiritual activity of heaven. This is why they had detailed plans on how to construct the Tabernacle of Moses and the Tabernacle of David. It was a prophetic insight as to how heaven operates around the throne of God and how humanity may interact with the Glory of God.

**Exodus 25:8-9 "And let them make Me a sanctuary, that I may dwell among them. ' According to all that I show you, *that is*, the pattern of the tabernacle and the pattern of all its furnishings, just so you shall make it."**

***1 Chronicles 28:11-12*** "Then David gave his son Solomon the plans for the vestibule, its houses, its treasuries, its upper chambers, its inner chambers, and the place of the mercy seat; and the plans for all that he had by the Spirit, of the courts of the house of the LORD, of all the chambers all around, of the treasuries of the house of God, and of the treasuries for the dedicated things."

A) Jesus taught His disciples to ask for the activity of heaven to come to the earth.

***Luke 11:1-2*** "Now it came to pass, as He was praying in a certain place, when He ceased, that one of His disciples said to Him, "Lord, teach us to pray, as John also taught his disciples." So He said to them, "When you pray, say:

***"Our Father in heaven, Hallowed be Your name.  
Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven."***

B) The Prophet Isaiah had a vision of the worship that takes place in heaven.

***Isaiah 6:1-3*** "In the year that King Uzziah died, I saw the Lord sitting on a throne, high and lifted up, and the train of His robe filled the temple. <sup>2</sup> Above it stood seraphim; each one had six wings: with two he covered his face, with two he covered his feet, and with two he flew. <sup>3</sup> And one cried to another and said:

***" Holy, holy, holy is the LORD of hosts;  
The whole earth is full of His glory!"***

## II. GOD HAS DELEGATED HIS GOVERNING AUTHORITY TO THE CHURCH- THROUGH INTERCESSION

Through out bible history, God has been consistent in having the church be the integral instrument that He has used to shift nations, change key circumstances and move the hand of God through the power of prayer. God has chosen to use prayer as the means by which He will govern the universe and release His will upon the nations.

Exodus 32:10-14, Daniel 9:1-19, Acts 12:5-9, Colossians 1:9-11

A) Abraham- Genesis 18:16-23

1. Abraham is given revelation to God's plan in judging Sodom and Gomorrah-v.16
2. God reveals His plan to intercessors- v.17
3. Intercessors like Abraham have an intimate knowledge of God-v.19
4. Intercessors are friends of God who draw near to Him in confidence-v.23

B) The Intercession of Aaron the High Priest- Numbers 16:44-48

1. God's anger burned hotly against the people of Israel to consume them-v.45
2. Moses and Aaron present incense before the Lord to deal with the plague. v. 46-47
3. Intercession is the ability to stand between the Lord and the people. V. 48

C) Moses had a glimpse of the nature of worship that takes place in heaven.

***Exodus 30:1 "You shall make an altar to burn incense on; you shall make it of acacia wood."***

***Exodus 30:6-8 "And you shall put it before the veil that is before the ark of the Testimony, before the mercy seat that is over the Testimony, where I will meet with you. "Aaron shall burn on it sweet incense every morning; when he tends the lamps, he shall burn incense on it. \* And when Aaron lights the lamps at twilight, he shall burn incense on it, a perpetual incense before the LORD throughout your generations."***

D) David had direct prophetic direction from the prophets who served underneath his leadership. The prophets, Nathan and Gad, revealed to David the critical need to have continual worship- 24/7, before the Lord on a daily basis.

***2 Chronicles 29:25 "And he stationed the Levites in the house of the LORD with cymbals, with stringed instruments, and with harps, according to the commandment of David, of Gad the king's seer, and of Nathan the prophet; for thus was the commandment of the LORD by His prophets."***

E) The Apostle John was also given revelation into the activity of heaven that takes place surrounding the Throne of God. John saw both, heavenly beings and redeemed human beings, worshiping around the throne 24/7 in conjunction with continual Intercession. This is a clear picture of heavenly activity that supports the Harp (worship) and Bowl (prayer) model.

***Revelation 5:8 "Now when He had taken the scroll, the four living creatures and the twenty-four elders fell down before the Lamb, each having a harp, and golden bowls full of incense, which are the prayers of the saints."***

### III. THE INTERCESSION OF THE END-TIME CHURCH

There can be no doubt that the Lord is orchestrating a worldwide prayer movement in all the nations of the earth. Never before in all of history, has there been such a worldwide emphasis on prayer, fasting, and intercession. This is a clear prophetic sign that the Holy Spirit is preparing His people for the coming of the Lord Jesus Christ. The book of Revelation clearly depicts a church that is fully engaged with the Spirit of Intercession in manifesting the will of God on the earth. The end-times will be a clash between two houses of worship, two houses of prayer.

A. The cry of both the heavenly anthem and the earthly declaration releases the Lamb to receive the title deed to the earth and commissioning the angels to release the first set of 7 judgments, the 7 seals of God for the shaking of the nations.  
-Revelation 6:1-8:6

***Revelation 5:8 "Now when He had taken the scroll, the four living creatures and the twenty-four elders fell down before the Lamb, each having a harp, and golden bowls full of incense, which are the prayers of the saints."***

B. The 7<sup>th</sup> seal releases another set of 7 judgments, the 7 trumpets, more severe than the 7 seals. Again, prayer is the very thing that precedes the release of this new set of judgments. -Revelation 8:7-11:19

***Revelation 8:1-6*** "When He opened the seventh seal, there was silence in heaven for about half an hour. <sup>2</sup> And I saw the seven angels who stand before God, and to them were given seven trumpets. <sup>3</sup> Then another angel, having a golden censer, came and stood at the altar. He was given much incense, that he should offer it with the prayers of all the saints upon the golden altar which was before the throne. <sup>4</sup> And the smoke of the incense, with the prayers of the saints, ascended before God from the angel's hand. <sup>5</sup> Then the angel took the censer, filled it with fire from the altar, and threw it to the earth. And there were noises, thunderings, lightnings, and an earthquake. <sup>6</sup> So the seven angels who had the seven trumpets prepared themselves to sound."

C. The 7<sup>th</sup> trumpet releases yet another set of 7 Judgments, the 7 bowls even more severe and devastating than the 7 trumpets. Again we see how the ministry of the saints unto the Lord is the very thing that releases this last set of Judgments on the earth. -Revelations 16:1-21

***Revelation 15:3-4*** "They sing the song of Moses, the servant of God, and the song of the Lamb, saying: " Great and marvelous are Your works, Lord God Almighty! Just and true are Your ways, O King of the saints! <sup>4</sup> Who shall not fear You, Lord, and glorify Your name? For You alone are holy. For all nations shall come and worship before You, For Your judgments have been manifested."
